Dear Parent/Carer/Stakeholder or Partner

Whilst academy status frees the school from Local Authority control it does not mean that we wish to work any less closely with them. Indeed, we wish to use these new circumstances to develop and strengthen all our partnerships in mutually beneficial ways.

The small amount of extra funding available to academies will also pay for some additional services and allow us to become more efficient and effective, for the benefit of our school and all our pupils, by ensuring that we continue to provide:

- High standards of behaviour
- Decisive and responsive leadership
- Strong partnerships
