## **Our Y11 Leavers Hoodies have arrived!**

We are obviously very keen to distribute hoodies to our pupils but, as you no doubt will agree, any system we choose needs to be fully compliant in terms of social distancing and keeping everyone safe. Unfortunately, we simply cannot have any type of group gathering related to hoodies.

For these reasons, we have chosen to operate a **“Click and Collect”** style booking system whereby hoodies can be collected by individual pupils whilst they undertake their daily exercise, at **pre-booked times between 9:00am and 3.30pm on the following days:**

11J1	Monday 18 <sup>th</sup> May
11B1	Tuesday 19 <sup>th</sup> May
11H1	Wednesday 20 <sup>th</sup> May
11H2	Thursday 21 <sup>st</sup> May

To log in, both parent and student details must be submitted.

Should anyone have difficulty with the booking system then they should contact Mr Chalk for assistance, [chalk.d@thornhillacademy.com](mailto:chalk.d@thornhillacademy.com). Hoodies will be distributed in the small hall area accessed from the Y7 base door in the school yard and therefore eliminating the need for any student to come into school via reception.

In order to maintain social distancing rules, hoodies will be issued to individual pupils at their allocated time and upon collection of hoodies pupils must leave the school site immediately. **Hoodies not collected during this window will not be available for collection until sometime in June, using a similar system.**

I apologise for the somewhat serious tone of this letter when in usual circumstances the issuing of hoodies would be seen as a happier social event. However, we must all appreciate the current situation but still look forward to happier times ahead when we will be able to have our Y11 pupils meet together as the class of 2020 and celebrate their time here at Thornhill.
