



Dear Year 11 Pupils, Parents and Carers,

Re: Examination Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2020

We are pleased to be able to invite our Year 11 pupils in to school on **Thursday 20th August** between **10am and 12 noon** to collect their GCSE results.

In line with government guidelines we are taking precautions to reduce risk of COVID-19 infection. We must ask that pupils do not congregate both outside and on the school premises; that only those collecting results enter the school building and that pupils leave school once they have collected their results.

Pupils should enter the school building via the main reception and results will be available to be collected from the main hall. Pupils must follow the strict social distancing measures that are in place, follow the one way system and sanitise their hands on arrival.

A number of school staff will be available on results day to help deal with any queries that pupils may have along with a representative from Sunderland College so that we can support you to access your next steps in Education, Employment and Training.

If a pupil is unable to attend and wishes for another family member to collect their results, they must bring with them a form of identification along with a letter signed by the pupil giving their permission for results to be issued. Any results not collected on results day will be posted home on Thursday 20th August.
