Dear parent/carer,

Firstly, I would like to say thank you for giving your child permission to be a member of Thornhill School's Film Club this year. I am sure you will agree it will be a rewarding experience for your child.

As part of your child's Film Club experience, we plan to take 20 members of our film club to a free screening of "**X-Men: Days of Future Past**" (rated 12A). The visit is scheduled for **Wednesday 5th November at 10am**.

Every year, local cinemas take part in a celebration of cinema by hosting the **First National Youth Film Festival**. We are lucky that **Empire Cinemas in Sunderland** have decided to be one of the hosting cinemas this year.

The itinerary for the day will be as follows:

8.40am – Pupils will attend their tutor group session as normal.

9.05am - Pupils will meet in the school yard. We will walk to the cinema from school.  
Pupils will be accompanied by two members of staff throughout their visit.

9.35am – Pupils will arrive at Empire Cinema, Sunderland.

The screening of the film is scheduled for 10am but we have been advised to arrive early.

11.50am – Film ends. Pupils leave the cinema to walk back to school.

12.30pm – Pupils arrive back at school in time for lunch.

As you have already signed an official Film Club consent form, which includes giving permission for your child to take part in visits for Film Club, you will not be expected to complete another. However, if you have any concerns, or you do not wish your child to attend the free screening, please advise me of this in a letter as soon as possible.

As this is classified as a school trip, you will need to complete the accompanying indemnity form. This must be returned to me no later than **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October**.
